1. Einleitung

2. Offer to obtain the source code

- 2.1 Some Open Source licenses also provide that the user must have the option to obtain the source code of the Open Source software used. In this respect the following offer applies.
- 2.2 Stiebel Eltron GmbH & Co. KG offers, upon written requests made to Stiebel Eltron GmbH & Co. KG - Kundenservice -, Dr.-Stiebel-Str. 33, 37603 Holzminden, Germany, to send the source code for software contained in Stiebel Eltron products licensed under GPL or LGPL or some other Open Source licenses on a physical medium for a fee in the amount of the reasonable costs incurred, in particular the cost of the medium used, shipment and processing. This offer remains valid for the duration for which customer service for the respective Stiebel Eltron product is offered, but at least for a period of three years from delivery of the respective product.

3. Libraries libm.a and libgcc.a

- 3.1 Part of the firmware is library libm.a including the folders newlib and libgloss. The parts of the library are subject to the GPL or LGPL Open Source license printed below. Individual parts are also subject to other Open Source licenses which are then referred to separately under specification of the respective authors.
- 3.2 Library libgcc.a, which is also used, is subject to the GPL Open Source license, however with the modification that a compiled link of the libraries is possible, as done, without any special conditions ("binary exception clause").

1. Введение

- 2.2 Stiebel Eltron GmbH & Co. KG จัดเตรียมซอร์สโค้ดของซอฟต์แวร์ที่ได้รับอนุญาตภายใต้สัญญาอนุญาต GPL หรือ LGPL หรือสัญญาอนุญาตโอเพนซอร์สอื่น ๆ ที่มีอยู่ในผลิตภัณฑ์ Stiebel Eltron บนสื่อกลางทางกายภาพโดยไม่ต้องชำระค่าธรรมเนียมที่เกิดขึ้นในการดำเนินการดังกล่าว โดยเฉพาะอย่างยิ่งค่าใช้จ่ายของสื่อที่เกี่ยวข้อง การขนส่งและการจัดการ เมื่อมีการร้องขอเป็นลายลักษณ์อักษรถึง Stiebel Eltron GmbH & Co. KG - ฝ่ายบริการลูกค้า - Dr.-Stiebel-Str. 33 โฮลชัมินเดิน เยอรมนี 37603 ข้อเสนอนี้ใช้ได้ตลอดเวลาที่เสนอให้บริการลูกค้าสำหรับผลิตภัณฑ์ Stiebel Eltron ที่เกี่ยวข้อง ในกรณีที่มีการส่งมอบผลิตภัณฑ์ที่เกี่ยวข้องแล้วเป็นเวลาอย่างน้อย 3 ปีเท่านั้น

3. ไลบรารี libm.a และ libgcc.a

- 3.1 ส่วนประกอบของเฟิร์มแวร์คือไลบรารี libm.a รวมไปถึงโคเรกทอรี newlib และ libgloss ส่วนประกอบของไลบรารีอยู่ภายใต้สัญญาอนุญาตโอเพนซอร์ส GPL หรือ LGPL ซึ่งเผยแพร่ไว้ต่อไปนี้ ในแต่ละส่วนยังอยู่ภายใต้สัญญาอนุญาตโอเพนซอร์สอื่นๆ ซึ่งจะอ้างอิงแยกกันและระบุเจ้าของลิขสิทธิ์ที่เกี่ยวข้อง
- 3.2 ไลบรารี libgcc.a ที่ใช้อยู่ได้รับอนุญาตภายใต้สัญญาอนุญาตโอเพนซอร์ส GPL เช่นเดียวกัน แต่ด้วยการดัดแปลง ลิงก์ที่รวบรวมไลบรารี - นั้น - สามารถเป็นไปได้อาจไม่จำเป็นต้องมีเงื่อนไขพิเศษ ("binary exception clause")

- 2.1 من أجل الوفاء بهذه الالتزامات فيما يتعلق باستخدام البرمجيات مفتوحة المصدر، تم الكشف عن شروط الترخيص الواردة أدناه، ويُشار إلى أن شروط الترخيص الواردة أدناه تنطبق على البرامج مفتوحة المصدر المذكورة في كل حالة.

KG - خدمة العملاء - Dr.-Stiebel-Str. 33، 37603 Holzminden، ألمانيا. هذا العرض صالح للمدة التي يتم خلالها تقديم خدمة العملاء لمنتج Stiebel Eltron المعني، ولكن لمدة ثلاث سنوات على الأقل من تاريخ تسليم المنتج المعني.
- 3. مكتبات libgcc.a و libm.a**
- 1.3 تتضمن البرامج الثابتة مكتبة libm.a، بما في ذلك سجلات newlib و libgloss. تخضع مكونات المكتبة لتراخيص مفتوح المصدر GPL أو LGPL، والتي تتم طباعتها أدناه. تخضع الأجزاء الفردية أيضاً لتراخيص أخرى مفتوحة المصدر، والتي يُشار إليها بعد ذلك بشكل منفصل وتتم الإشارة إلى المؤلفين المعنيين.
- 2.3 المكتبة libgcc.a، والتي يتم استخدامها أيضاً، تخضع لتراخيص GPL مفتوح المصدر، ولكن مع التعديل الذي يمكن أن يؤدي إلى ارتباط مترجم للمكتبة -كما حدث- دون أي شروط خاصة ("شرط الاستثناء الثنائي").

- b) Convey the object code in, or embodied in, a physical product (including a physical distribution medium), accompanied by a written offer, valid for at least three years and valid for as long as you offer spare parts or customer support for that product model, to give anyone who possesses the object code either (1) a copy of the Corresponding Source for all the software in the product that is covered by this License, on a durable physical medium customarily used for software interchange, for a price no more than your reasonable cost of physically performing this conveying of source, or (2) access to copy the Corresponding Source from a network server at no charge.

Each licensee is addressed as "you".

A "library" means a collection of software functions and/or data prepared so as to be conveniently linked with application programs (which use some of those functions and data) to form executables.

The "Library", below, refers to any such software library or work which has been distributed under these terms. A "work based on the Library" means either the Library or any derivative work under copyright law: that is to say, a work containing the Library or a portion of it, either verbatim or with modifications and/or translated straightforwardly into another language. (Hereinafter, translation is included without limitation in the term "modification".)

"Source code" for a work means the preferred form of the work for making modifications to it.
